● Runs 19:00 (departure Kanazawa Sta.) — 22:36 (arrival Kanazawa Sta.)

● Fares (per ride): Adults 300 yen / Children 150 yen

*The Hokutetsu Bus One-day Pass (Adults ¥500, Children ¥250) cannot be used on the Kanazawa Light-up Bus.

● Sold at: Hokutetsu Ekimae Ticket Office (near the Kanazawa Sta. East Gate Bus Terminal #1, open until 20:00), Hokutetsu Group Information Desk (near the Kanazawa Sta. East Gate Bus Terminal #7, open until 20:00), Hokutetsu Bus Kata-machi Center (open until 19:00), and some hotels in Kanazawa (Refer to the map on the reverse side).
